Why do we celebrate halloween?

The easy answer to this question is that no one really knows the origins of Halloween. What we do know for sure is that Halloween is on the eve of a major Catholic festival, All Saints (1st November) and the eve of the pagan Celtic festival known as Samhain.

Currently, it is widely thought that Halloween originated as a pagan Celtic festival of the dead related to the Irish and Scottish Samhain, but there is no evidence that it was connected with the dead in pre-Christian times.

Where does the name Halloween originate from?

Halloween comes from All Hallow Even, the eve (night before) All Hallows day. Therefore, Halloween is the eve of All Saints Day.

Did you know?

Our ancestors celebrated New Year on November 1st. They celebrated their New Year's Eve on October 31st. Samhain (pronounced 'sow-in') marked the end of the "season of the sun" (Summer) and the beginning of "the season of darkness and cold" (Winter).





Moving the Clocks Forward / Back one hour in the UK



Changing the clocks

In the UK, we all change our clocks and watches by one hour, twice a year.

Last Sunday in March

We **add an hour** and go onto what is called **British Summer Time** (BST).

Last Sunday in October

We put our clocks **back one hour** and adhere to **Greenwich Mean Time** (GMT).



When do the clocks change in the UK? October 2018

Clocks move backwards one hour.

Sunday **28 October** 02:00 BST** (01:00 GMT)

** As the UK will be on BST (British Summer Time), we will change our clocks at **2 am** on Sunday 28 October.



What time do the clocks change?

The clocks are always changed at **01:00 GMT (02:00 BST)**.

In the Autumn (October), as we are on BST (British Summer Time) before the clocks change, we change the clocks at 02:00.



Why do we change our clocks?

We've been changing our clocks forwards and backwards in the UK since 1916. It's all to do with saving the hours of daylight, and it was started by a man called **William Willett**, a London builder, who lived in Petts Wood in Kent.

William Willett first proposed the idea of British Summer Time in 1907 in a pamphlet entitled '**The Waste of Daylight**'. Willett had noticed that the summer mornings light was wasted while people slept, and that the time would be better utilised in the afternoon by putting the clocks forward. After campaigning for years the British Government finally adopted the system a year after Willett's death.

Nowadays, this practice is done to make the most of the natural daylight, to reduce accidents, to conserve electricity, to encourage people to engage in fitness activities, such as walking, jogging and sports.
